



**COAST SALISH CULTURAL EDUCATION KIT
RENTAL AND SERVICE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE
RENTON HISTORY MUSEUM AND THE SCHOOL**

The Coast Salish Cultural Education Agreement (the Agreement) is made effective
between the Renton History Museum (the Museum) and
..... (the School), regarding the rental of the Coast Salish Cultural
Education Kit (the Kit).

First-time users of the Coast Salish Curriculum (the Curriculum) and the Kit have the opportunity to schedule a one-hour orientation, free of charge, explaining the major differences between the Coast Salish and the Pacific Northwest Native American cultures, and providing useful tips in using the Kit.

Objects in the Kit subject to this Agreement:

 - cedar bark gathering basket
 - cedar limb/white clam basket
 - two cedar bark ropes
 - cattail mat
 - cedar river water canoe
 - cedar salt water canoe

Rental Fee and Security Deposit:

The rental fee of the Kit is \$100 plus a refundable \$200 security deposit, for a total of \$300.

Full payment, by cash, check, credit card or purchase order, must be made at the time of receipt of the Kit by the School.

The payment should be made to the Renton Historical Society and can be delivered or sent to the Renton History Museum, 235 Mill Ave. S., Renton, WA 98057.

Transport of the Kit:

The School is responsible for transporting the Kit from and to the Museum.

Acceptance of the Kit:

The Museum will provide an Inventory (the Inventory) of all items included in the Kit and a Condition Report (the Condition Report) of all Coast Salish replicas included in the Kit. The School and the Museum will fill out and sign outgoing and incoming Inventory and Condition Report during pick-up and drop-off of the Kit. The school may be subject to charges to the security deposit in case of failure to complete the condition report.

Safe-Keeping of the Kit:

The school is responsible for safe-keeping of the Kit on school premises. A locked room is required to store the Kit when it is not in use.

Return of the Kit:

The Kit should be returned to the museum on a mutually agreed upon date and time. There is a late return fee of \$10 per day. The Museum will refund the \$200 deposit, minus cost of loss or damage to the Kit and/or late return fee, within 30 days from the date of return of the whole Kit to the Museum.

Charges to the Security Deposit:

The Museum will apply the Security Deposit against late return and any damages or loss of object/s in the Kit in the following amounts:

- \$50 per replica
- Current replacement value of other non-replica objects (books, DVDs, etc.) in the Kit
- \$200 in case of the damage or loss of the whole Kit
- \$10 per day late fee
